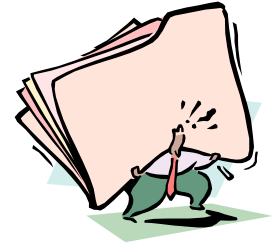


Have you fallen behind in your **Rent or Mortgage** payments?



The Housing Retention Program may be able to assist you!

To be **eligible** for assistance, you **must**:

- ✓ Live in one of the identified zip code areas
- ✓ Have a household income less than:

Family Size	1 person	2 persons	3 persons	4 persons	5 persons	6 persons
per Month	\$2,145	\$2,875	\$3,606	\$4,337	\$5,068	\$5,799

- ✓ Be experiencing a **short-term** financial crisis. (After you receive this one-time assistance, you will be able to pay **all** of your monthly bills).
- ✓ Currently reside in an **unsubsidized** housing unit (private market apartment/home),
- ✓ Have received written notification from their landlord/mortgage company that you will lose your housing unless some type of payment is received.
